

Stocky Alternatives — Comparison

As of 2026-08-09 | Compiled from each vendor's public website and Shopify App Store listing. Prices and features change, so **please verify against the current pages when you actually make a decision**. Source URLs and the date each was checked are in the footnotes.

Stocky — the inventory app bundled with Shopify POS Pro — **ends on 31 August 2026, and every Stocky API stops that day**. Stocky then remains read-only for export for at least 90 days, but suppliers cannot be exported from Stocky. This table lines up the main migration candidates. It also includes **Shopify's own native purchasing features (built into the admin, no extra cost)**, since that is the default destination for many stores.

Read this before comparing. UreyukiBox is built for stores selling in Japan. Its screens and purchase-order PDFs follow the Shopify admin language, so an English admin gets an English interface. **Notification emails, Slack and LINE messages, and the purchase orders you email to suppliers have also been available in English since 31 July 2026**, and **support is provided in Japanese and English** — notifications follow the store's country rather than the admin language. Several rows below score UreyukiBox highly precisely because of Japan-specific requirements (consumption tax categories and qualified-invoice numbers). If your store has no Japanese operation, those advantages will not apply to you. We would rather you knew that now.

※ UreyukiBox migration guarantee: if the Stocky API copy cannot be completed for reasons on our side, we refund the full subscription fee for the billing month immediately following the migration. CSV and paste imports are excluded (see the terms of service). ※ UreyukiBox's API route is available only through 31 August 2026. Imported suppliers feed current operations. Historical PO / general stock-adjustment details and purchase-tax-type masters (excluding sales-purpose rows) are stored in the database and the completion screen shows counts, but there is no UI to browse or export those historical details. API stock adjustments cannot identify stocktake history. Current-product tax assignments are not migrated automatically. Low Stock CSV supplies reorder points and lead times, individual stocktake CSVs preserve stocktake history, and paste import supplies MOQs. ※1 Current native functionality documented in Shopify's official Stocky transition guide (source in footnotes). ※2 The same guide states that historical POs cannot be imported into Shopify, Stocky remains read-only for export for at least 90 days after shutdown, and suppliers cannot be exported (source in footnotes).

Where UreyukiBox genuinely fits — and where it does not

It fits when you sell in Japan.

1. **Prices are fixed by Shopify billing currency.** JPY-billed stores pay ¥0–¥12,800; every non-JPY store pays \$0–\$83 per month. These are separate fixed plan prices, not an estimated currency conversion.

2. **Qualified-invoice purchase orders are standard.** 8%/10% consumption tax categories and the registration number are printed, so the PO is usable as-is in Japanese trade practice.
3. **The Stocky API copy is automatic and carries a limited guarantee.** Through 31 August 2026, it copies suppliers, POs, stock adjustments and purchase tax types (excluding sales-purpose rows) with their relationships intact. Suppliers feed current operations; historical PO / adjustment details are count-only in the current UI, and current-product tax assignments are not migrated automatically. If we cannot complete the API copy for reasons on our side, we refund the billing month immediately following the migration; CSV and paste imports are excluded. Stores that never used Stocky skip migration entirely.

It does not fit if you have no Japanese operation. The screens work in English, but the advantages that put UreyukiBox at the top of several rows above are Japan-specific — consumption-tax categories and qualified-invoice numbers — and neither helps a store selling elsewhere. If that is your situation, Fabrikatör and Inventory Planner are the more sensible comparisons on this table.

- **Assisty** — closer to a reporting / BI tool at its core, with weaker purchase-order automation (as reviewed May 2026; verify current state).
