

UreyukiBox — Product Overview

Stocky, Shopify's own inventory and purchasing app, ends on 31 August 2026, and every Stocky API stops that day. It remains read-only for export for at least 90 days, but suppliers cannot be exported from Stocky. UreyukiBox has been **live on the Shopify App Store since 30 July 2026** for stores selling in Japan that need a new purchasing workflow.

UreyukiBox is **one Stocky migration option for stores selling in Japan**. It provides a daily ordering / receiving workflow, Japanese and qualified-invoice support, and persistent demand / lead-time / MOQ policies. The **order-to-receipt loop runs entirely inside the app**, writing stock back to the same native Shopify ledger Stocky used. Stock adjustments, stocktakes and barcode scanning are supported; transfers between locations require Business.

A note on language. The interface follows your Shopify admin language: if your admin is set to English, UreyukiBox's screens, its purchase-order PDFs and its barcode labels are in English. **Notification emails, Slack and LINE messages, and the purchase orders you email to suppliers have also been available in English since 31 July 2026**, and **support is provided in Japanese and English** — notifications follow the store's country rather than the admin language, so a Japanese store keeps Japanese. The product is built for stores selling in Japan — consumption-tax categories and qualified-invoice numbers only matter if you have a Japanese operation.

Core capabilities

Capability	What it does
Reorder reminders	Sales velocity, safety stock, intermittent demand and a 51-country seasonal calendar. Event timing does not require a full year of history, but quantities use the store's own sales; where there is no basis, no numeric suggestion is produced. The arithmetic stays visible on screen
Qualified-invoice purchase orders	Drafts a PO per supplier automatically. Edit quantity, unit price and tax category (reduced 8% / standard 10%), then export to PDF or CSV, or email it to the supplier. Prints the qualified-invoice registration number (T + 13 digits) and your own business details
Receiving and PO status	"Mark as ordered" confirms a PO and deducts the incoming quantity from the next suggestion. Record receipts including partial deliveries, with barcode scanning

Capability	What it does
Warehouse operations	Stock adjustments with reason codes, stocktakes (barcode scanning or a bulk CSV of counted quantities), transfers between locations (Business), barcode label printing
Landed cost	Allocate freight, duties and other charges across the lines of a purchase order to get a landed unit cost (Pro and above). Allocate by value or by quantity. Never written back to the product cost
Profit and supplier reports	Margin by product, plus order volume, average lead time and on-time rate by supplier, over a date range (Pro and above). Lines excluded for a missing cost or unsynced revenue are always reported as a count
Notifications	Email / Slack / LINE (Slack and LINE on Pro; LINE once per day). Message language follows the store's country
Interface language	Japanese and English — follows your Shopify admin language automatically. Purchase-order PDFs, barcode labels and CSVs are localised too; notifications and supplier PO emails are available in English
Seasonal / tax country presets	Seasonal events for 51 countries; purchasing-tax presets for 53. US, CA, BR, HK, ID and MY provide labels without a prefilled rate
Stocky migration (optional)	API copy of suppliers, POs, general stock adjustments and purchase tax types (excluding sales-purpose rows) through 31 August, plus Low Stock CSV (reorder points / lead times), individual stocktake CSVs and Vendor → Order limits paste for MOQ. Stores that never used Stocky skip this

Safety — stock changes only when you act

Syncing, forecasting and drafting purchase orders **read** your Shopify data and nothing more. Your Shopify stock changes only when **you** act in the app — recording a receipt, recording a stock adjustment, confirming a stocktake, or recording a transfer between locations. Nothing is written automatically. By design, installing the app cannot leave your stock out of step.

Migration and refund guarantee

If the Stocky API copy cannot be completed for reasons on our side, we **refund the full subscription fee for the billing month immediately following the migration**. CSV and paste imports are excluded.

Imported suppliers feed current operations. Historical PO / adjustment details and purchase-tax-type masters (excluding sales-purpose rows) are stored in the database and the completion screen reports counts, but the current app has no UI to browse or export those historical details. Current-product tax assignments are not migrated automatically.

The Free plan already covers manual qualified-invoice purchase orders, inventory visibility and the Stocky import routes described above. Automatic order-quantity calculation, reorder-point management, auto-drafting from the forecast and the daily email alert start at Starter; Slack and LINE alerts at Pro.

Shopify bills the fixed JPY amount to JPY-billed stores and the fixed USD amount to every non-JPY store. Per-location destinations and analysis work up to each plan's location cap; transfers between locations require Business. (Pricing as of 2026-08-09.)

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
