

UreyukiBox Roadmap — what ships today (v1), and what comes next

※ The app is live on the Shopify App Store. Everything listed under "v1 — available today" is currently in production.

A note on possible future work "Coming next" is a set of candidates, not a delivery promise. There is no committed order, scope or date. **Base any purchasing decision only on what is available today.** A dedicated Shopify POS UI and importing sales from other channels are also unsupported, with no promised delivery date.

A note on language. The interface follows your Shopify admin language — an English admin gets English screens, purchase-order PDFs and barcode labels (shipped 31 July 2026). **Notification emails, Slack and LINE messages, and the purchase orders you email to suppliers have also been available in English since the same date,** and **support is provided in Japanese and English** — notifications follow the store's country rather than the admin language.

v1 — what is available today

One automatic cycle every morning takes you from noticing, to deciding, to producing the paperwork, to receiving the goods. (For the mechanics in detail, see document 05, "How it works".)

- **Once every morning, automatically:** UreyukiBox **reads** your Shopify products, orders, inventory and incoming shipments. The sync never writes back to your Shopify stock.
- **Sales aggregation and demand forecast:** a per-product daily sales rate from the store's own sales, adjusted for safety stock, **a 51-country seasonal calendar** and intermittent demand. Event timing does not require a full year of history, but quantities need the store's own sales; where there is no basis, no numeric suggestion is produced. Backtesting is available and the calculation stays visible on screen.
- **Automatic order quantity:** order quantity = reorder point – on hand – incoming – already ordered. Deducting incoming and already-ordered quantities is what prevents double ordering.
- **Alerts:** low-stock notifications by email / Slack / LINE (email from Starter; Slack and LINE from Pro).
- **Purchase orders:** a qualified-invoice-compliant PO is drafted per supplier (8% / 10% tax categories, registration number printed, unit price taken from manual entry > Shopify cost > estimate, in that order). **Export as PDF or CSV, or email it to the supplier from inside the app.** From there, "mark as ordered" through to recording the receipt all happens **within UreyukiBox**. You can also hand it to Shopify's native purchase-order screen by CSV import (if you run both, manage each PO in one place only).
- **Warehouse operations: stock adjustments with reason codes, stocktakes, barcode scanning for receiving and counting, and barcode label printing.** Transfers between locations require Business; multiple suppliers per SKU require Pro or above.
- **Day-to-day purchasing tools:** minimum order quantity (MOQ), target service level and a purchasing cash-flow calendar (Starter and above); inventory analysis and bundle/BOM stock (Pro and above). Location caps are Free 1, Starter 2, Pro 5, Business unlimited; transfers between locations require Business.
- **Country tax presets:** purchasing-tax presets cover 53 countries. US, CA, BR, HK, ID and MY provide category names without a prefilled rate.

When Shopify stock actually changes (by design)

The morning sync is read-only and never rewrites stock. Your Shopify stock changes only when **you** act in the app. There are exactly four such actions:

1. **Recording a receipt** with "reflect in Shopify inventory" selected (only the quantity received)
2. **Recording a stock adjustment** (logged with a reason code such as damage or loss)
3. **Confirming a stocktake** (the difference against the counted quantity)
4. **Recording a transfer between locations** (both origin and destination)

Each one shows you what will happen before you confirm it. Because no automated process writes stock, **installing the app cannot leave your inventory out of step.**

Migrating from Stocky (four-step wizard, from the Free plan)

1. **Step 1** — read the guide
2. **Step 2** — enter your Stocky credentials
3. **Step 3** — wait for the import to finish
4. **Step 4** — check the record counts

Every Stocky API stops on 31 August 2026. Until then, suppliers, POs, stock adjustments and purchase tax types (excluding sales-purpose rows) can be copied with their relationships intact. Suppliers feed current operations. Historical PO / adjustment details and purchase-tax-type masters (excluding sales-purpose rows) are stored in the database and the completion screen shows counts, but there is no browse / export UI for historical details and current-product tax assignments are not migrated automatically. Low Stock / stocktake CSV and MOQ paste are separate routes. If our API copy cannot complete for reasons on our side, the stated limited refund guarantee applies; CSV and paste imports are excluded.

※ **Stores that never used Stocky do not need this step at all.** Install, sync your inventory, and you can go straight from setting reorder points to producing purchase orders.

The Free plan covers manual qualified-invoice purchase orders, inventory visibility and the Stocky migration. Automatic order-quantity calculation, reorder-point management, auto-drafting from the forecast and the daily email alert start at Starter; Slack and LINE alerts at Pro.

Paid plans include a 14-day free trial. Shopify bills the fixed JPY price to JPY-billed stores and the fixed USD price to every non-JPY store. Pricing as of 2026-08-09.

Possible future work — no delivery commitment

The following items are unsupported candidates. There is no committed implementation, order or date.

Read each one against "how v1 handles it today", and decide based only on current functionality.

※ **The following were previously on this roadmap and are now shipped in v1:** intermittent-demand handling and backtesting; emailing purchase orders to suppliers; barcode receiving and stocktakes; stock adjustments; transfers between locations (Business); multiple suppliers per SKU, **landed cost**, and **profit / supplier reports** (all three on Pro and above); **an English UI**. Numeric first-lot suggestions for products with no sales history are not exposed in the public UI.

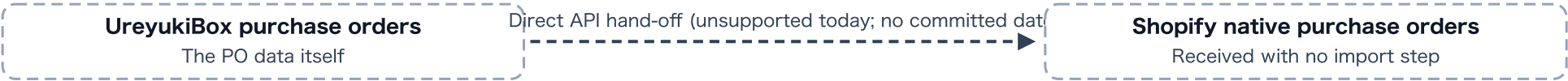

④	Landed cost — allocate freight, duties and other charges across the lines of a purchase order to get a landed unit cost	Shipped (Pro and above). Allocate by value or by quantity. 🛑 The landed cost is display only — it is never written back to the product cost, because it would go stale the moment a line is edited
⑤	Profit and supplier reports — margin by product, and order volume, average lead time and on-time rate by supplier	Shipped (Pro and above), over a date range you choose. 🛑 Lines with no cost set, and lines whose revenue has not synced yet, are excluded from the totals and the excluded count is shown on screen — so an unpriced product never inflates margin. Costs come from the product's <i>current</i> setting, so these are not frozen historical figures
⑥	English UI — screens and documents in English	Shipped on 31 July 2026. The interface follows your Shopify admin language automatically; purchase-order PDFs, barcode labels and CSV exports are localised too. Notification emails, Slack and LINE messages, and supplier purchase-order emails have also been available in English since the same date — those go by the store's country. Support is provided in Japanese and English
